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Steps for Use of Product	Donning:
	1. Grasp the end of the elastic or plain glove cuff and begin gently pulling glove onto hand.
	2. When sleeve is half to 3/4 up onto the forearm.
	a. Start pulling gently on the middle part of sleeve.
	b. Lower part of sleeve so that the hand enters the glove portion.
	3. When fingers are in the glove and start to enter the finger portion of the glove:  a. Release the sleeve portion and start "milking" the glove and glove finger
	so that your fingers fit thoroughly into the glove.
	b. At this point, always use the non-seal area of the glove to secure a comfortable fit.
	Doffing:  1. Begin pulling one of the glove's fingers and thumb until your hand is in in the palm of the glove. (Repeat with the opposite hand.)
	2. Grasp and pull the fingers of one of the gloves until the wrist reaches the end of the sleeve. (Repeat with the opposite hand.)
	(Note: The sleeves are ready for removal once both hands reach the elastic cuffs.)  3. Grasp the inside of the opposite sleeve with the thumb and forefinger to remove
	both sleeve gloves.
